Members must follow the below guidelines while visiting JCNJ Facilities

We are happy to inform that after long wait we will finally be able to do **In-Person Prabhu Puja or Darshan** starting Thursday October 1st, 2020.

JCNJ will be open for darshan and Puja. Each visit for Puja or Darshan must be pre-booked by **APPOINTMENT** to make sure all of us able to follow New Jersey state and CDC guidelines. Please review the complete guidelines prior to signing up and visiting.

Key Details to Review Prior to Visiting any of JCNJ's Facilities:

1. Despite best efforts, JCNJ cannot guarantee the facilities to be completely free of any virus. You are asked to assess this and if you do visit the facilities, it must be done so at your own risk. Consider your vulnerability if you have any pre-existing conditions. **JCNJ is not liable for any infection resulting from visiting any of its facilities.**

- Each visit for puja must be **pre-booked online** prior to visiting by selecting your desired date and time slot. **Walk-ins for puja will not be allowed.** To book a time slot visit, <https://jaincenternj.org/events/rsvp-events/>. All information will be kept confidential.
- Each individual/family member will be allowed up to **30 minutes** at the facility to allow ample time for puja and Chatiya vandan.
- Facemasks are mandatory and will be strictly enforced.** The **masks should always be worn in JCNJ facilities.** It is also recommended that socks, and full body-covered clothing be used for your safety.
- We respectfully request you to stay at home if you or any family members residing with you is sick with a cold, cough, fever, allergy etc. or if you are exposed to a COVID-19 patient on a daily basis or have done any international travel in the last 14 days.

8. As you drive into JCNJ facilities parking lot, you are requested to park your vehicle leaving one empty space in between parked vehicles. This will allow visitors to enter and exit their vehicles while following social distancing guidelines.
9. Upon entering JCNJ facilities, it is mandatory that you clean your hands with the hand-sanitizers placed at various locations in JCNJ facilities. If you walked in with gloves on, please remove that pair, before sanitizing your hands. Do NOT put the same used pair of gloves on until you EXIT the facility. Please do NOT discard used gloves in the facility. If you want to wear gloves on while at the facility, please use a new pair.
10. Each group visiting should not be great than four individuals.
11. You are asked to maintain a **minimum safe distance of six feet** between you and other Sadharmik families who may be present in the facilities. The facilities areas are marked for ease of implementation of this rule. While in facilities, please refrain from touching surfaces as much as possible; refrain from using Ghant as it can become an easy means of transmission. Please comply.
12. Please **DO NOT** go to any other areas of the facility including auditorium, dining areas, Pathshala Rooms, Elevator, Showers, Changing Rooms etc. At Franklin Township facility, **restrooms will be open only on the first floor.**
13. Make sure you **do not socialize** inside OR outside the temple.
14. If you happen to find out you are a COVID-19 suspect, or are confirmed to have been infected within fourteen days from visiting JCNJ facilities, PLEASE inform JCNJ via email @ COVIDTeam@jaincenternj.org immediately. All information will be kept confidential.
15. Guidelines can change if required for the safety of Sangh members.
